

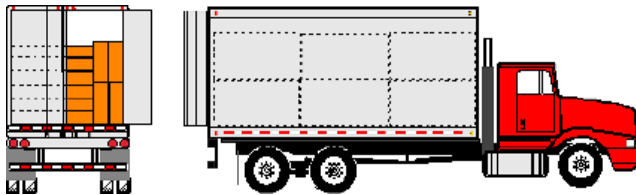
## Load Securement

In July 2005, The National Safety Code Cargo Securement Standard 10 came into effect across Canada.

The North American Cargo Securement Standard is a Canada-US co-operative project jointly administered by the Canadian Council of Motor Transport Administrators (CCMTA) and the Commercial Vehicle Safety Alliance (CVSA).
